

## Notebook Cover

### Materials

Fabric  
Paper  
Scissors  
Double sided tape  
Ribbon, buttons etc (optional)



### Instructions

1. Open the book out flat, cover facing up and put double sided tape along the top and bottom edges (don't peel off yet!)
2. Choose fabric, and lay pattern side face down.
3. Fold top and bottom longer edges to the inside so the total height is approx 4mm bigger at both top and bottom than the book. Run your nail, or the outside (not blade) edge of the scissors along the fold to hold in place.
4. Peel the tape, place notebook in the centre and open front cover, stick down, repeat with back cover, making sure you close the book as you do this, as this will require slightly more fabric.
5. Place a square of tape in the corners of the fabric, peel off and fold diagonally back onto itself.
6. Place tape along the edge of the fabric, peel and fold into the book cover. Repeat on other side, again making sure you close the book as you do this, as this will require slightly more fabric.
7. At this point add any decoration you wish (ribbons etc), this way you can tuck any loose ends to the inside. Use fabric glue, glue gun, or stitches as appropriate.
8. Choose your paper, cut to the same size as book and fold in half.
9. Place tape on the edges of the inside front cover and first page of the notebook.
10. Place the folded edge of the wallpaper in the centre of the notebook and stick down.
11. Repeat with the back cover.
12. Voila! Your completed notebook cover!
